## Directions & Map

## Parking

Parking is available in Lot 1 (see map). When arriving at the Conference please watch for parking guides who will direct you on where to park.

## Entrance

Look for the burgundy welcome banner which will direct you on the correct door to enter (door #6 - see map). This is a handicapped accessible building with ramps for easy access.

## Registration - Doors Open

## WiFi

There is guest access WiFi available throughout the Cousins Center. There is no password required. The guest network is setup for easy access. After connecting to the network, when you open a web browser, you are routed to a login page at <https://bluesocket.archmil.org>. This is similar to other public WiFi spots you will find at coffeehouses, etc. You should enter your email address in the guest area (yellow box) in the upper left hand corner of the browser window and click login there. Once logged in, your browser gets redirected to its home page. Users can browse the web, see YouTube videos, etc.
